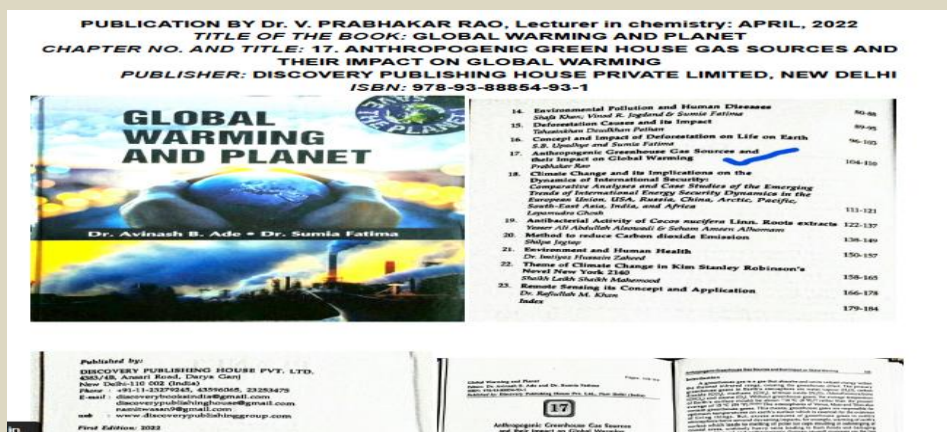


Fig. First few pages of the book published by Dr. V. Prabhakar Rao.

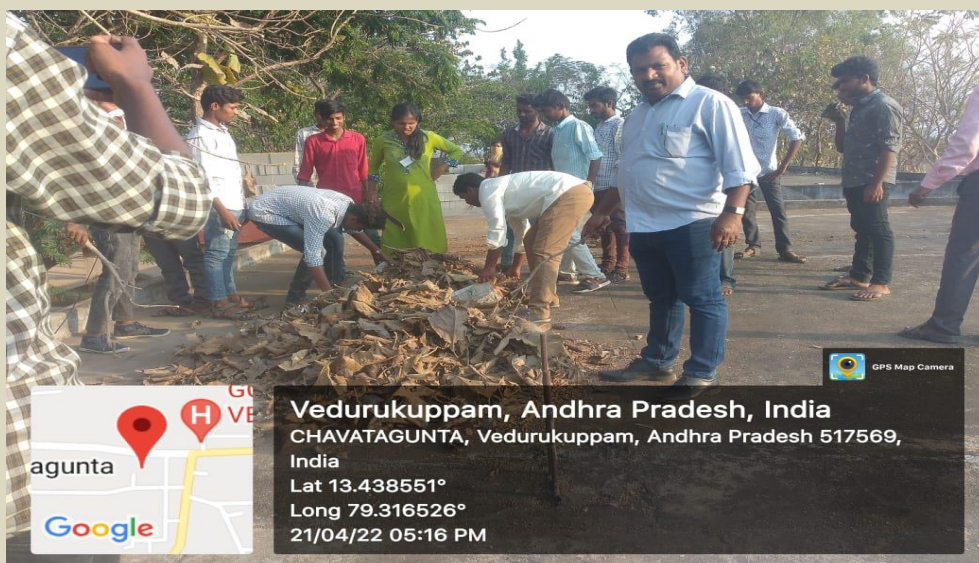

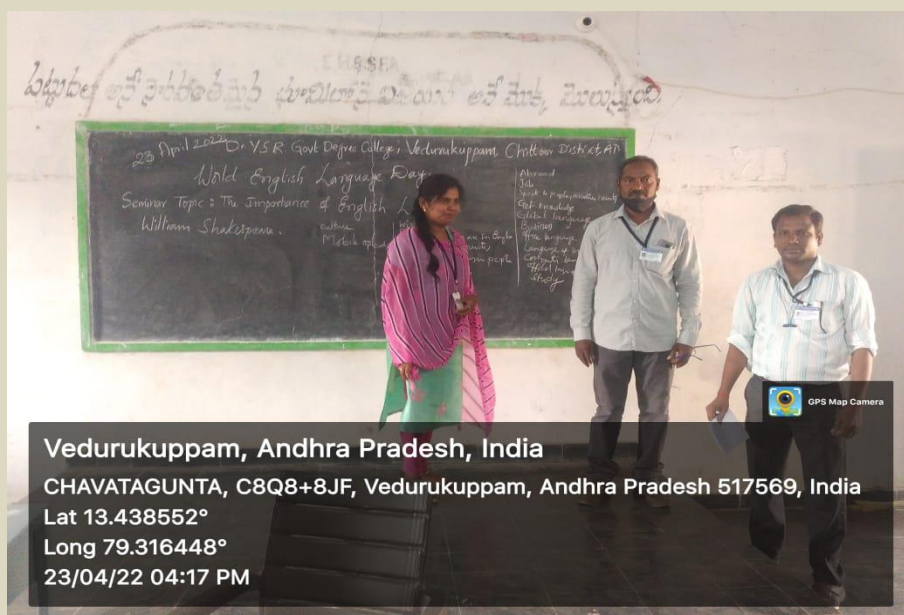
