The decision to erect Dr. YSR's statue likely

garnered support and involvement from various stakeholders, including the college community, alumni, local residents, and political organizations. Engaging these groups through open forums, public consultations, and awareness campaigns would have helped build consensus and foster a sense of ownership for the project. It is essential to ensure that the erection of the statue reflects the aspirations and values of the wider community.

The erection of the Dr. YSR statue in front of the college involved a systematic process and planning. The college administration, in consultation with relevant stakeholders, including students, faculty, and community members, likely formed a committee responsible for overseeing the project. The committee would have been tasked with:

- a. Site selection: Choosing an appropriate location in front of the college that provides visibility and allows for safe and convenient access to the statue.
- b. Design and sculpting: Collaborating with skilled artists or sculptors to create a life-like statue of Dr. YSR that captures his essence and portrays him in a dignified manner.
- c. Installation and unveiling: Coordinating with construction teams to ensure the statue's proper installation and organizing a formal unveiling ceremony to mark the completion of the project.
- d. Maintenance and preservation: Implementing measures to ensure the statue's upkeep.

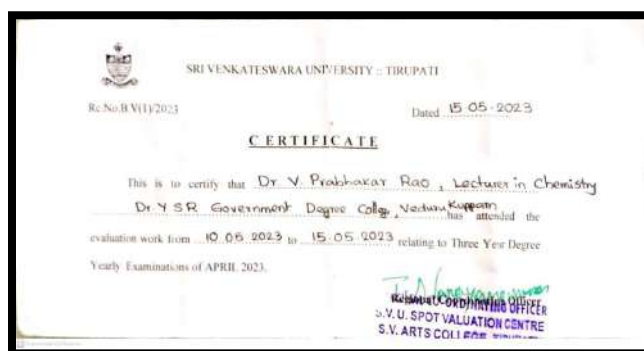
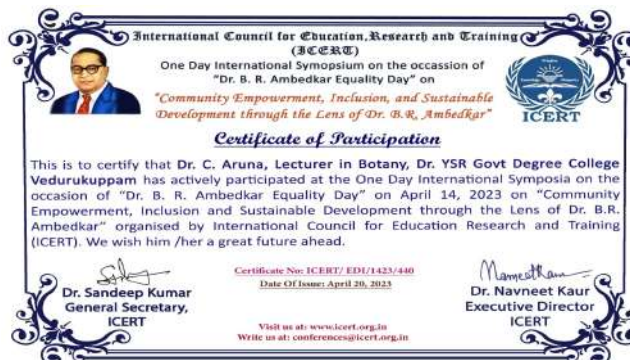


Fig.: Online participation certificates of Dr. YSR GDC, Vedurukuppam teaching staff.

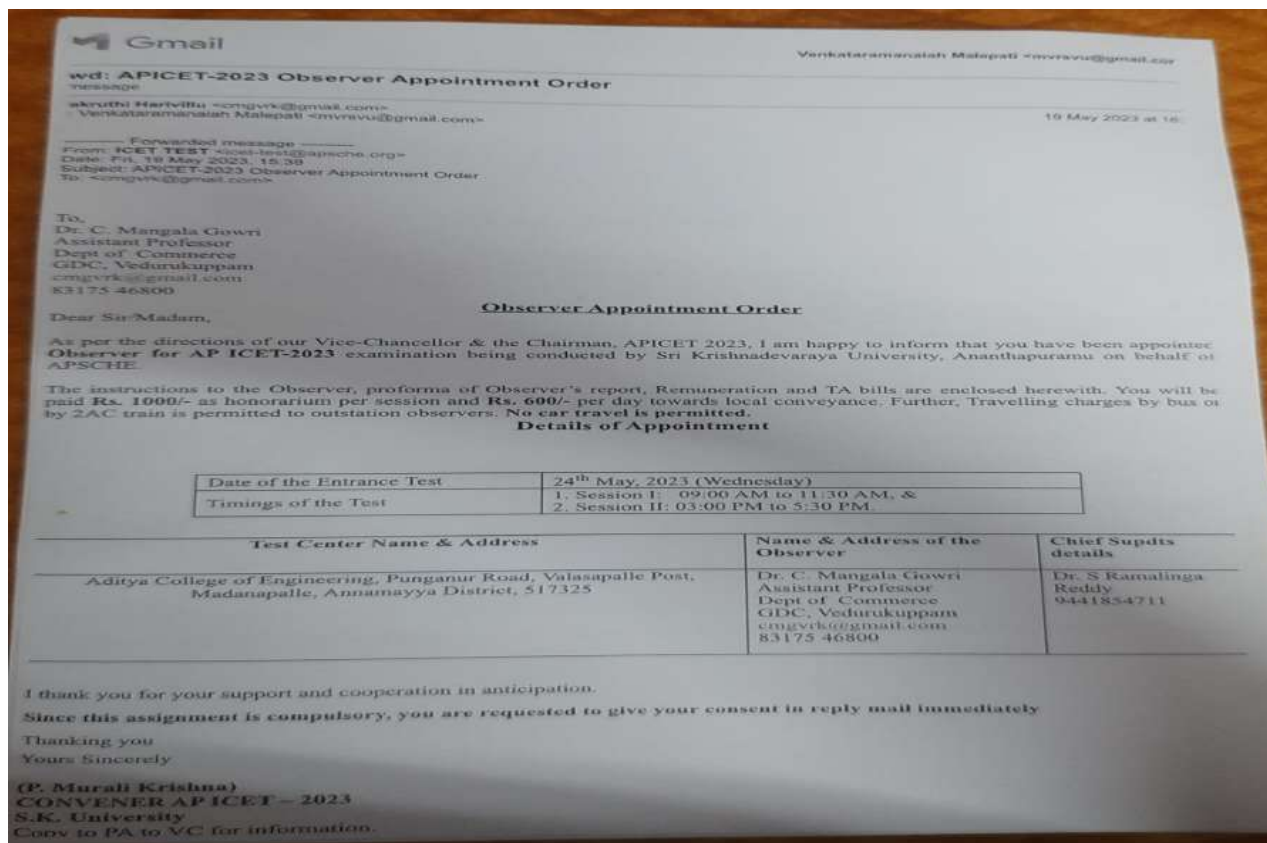


Fig: Dr. C. Mangalagowri acted as an Observer for APECET-2023

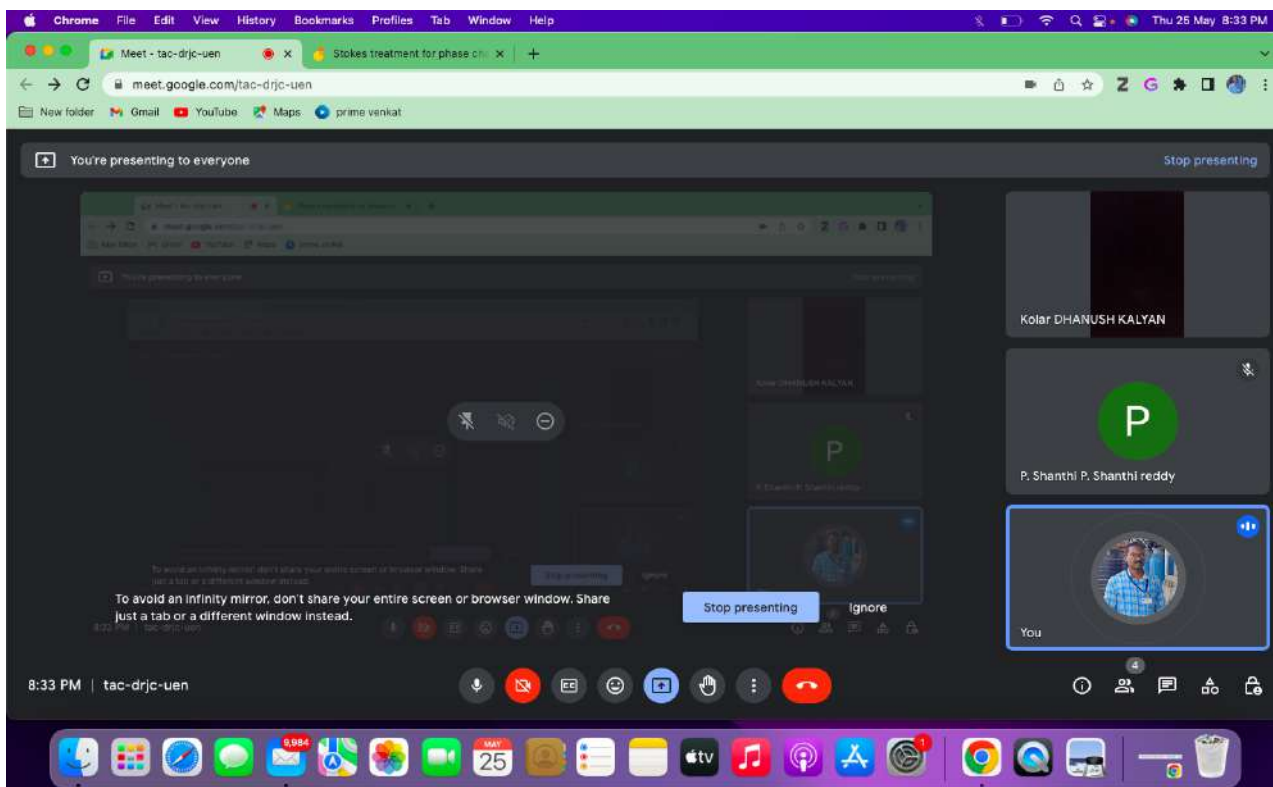
