Deworming Day **(10-02-2025)**

Vedurukuppam, February 10th, 2025 - A significant stride towards ensuring the well-being of its student body was taken by Government Degree College (GDC), Vedurukuppam, as it successfully conducted a Deworming Day on February 10th, 2025. This initiative, a collaborative effort by the National Service Scheme (NSS) unit and the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the college, aimed to eradicate intestinal worm infections, a common health issue, particularly in rural settings. The program was executed with the invaluable support of the local village Auxiliary Nurse Midwives (ANMs), demonstrating a strong community-college partnership.

The program was initiated under the visionary leadership of the college Principal, Dr. B. Annapoorna Sarada, aligning with the directives issued by the Commissionerate of Collegiate Education (CCE), Andhra Pradesh. Recognizing the importance of preventative healthcare, Dr. Sarada emphasized the college's commitment to fostering a healthy learning environment. The day's events saw a dedicated team of volunteers, comprising NSS members, college faculty, and ANMs, working diligently to ensure the smooth distribution of Albendazole tablets to all students. The systematic approach adopted by the team ensured that every student received the medication, along with proper guidance on its consumption and potential side effects.

Beyond the mere distribution of medication, the Deworming Day served as an educational platform. Awareness sessions were conducted, highlighting the importance of hygiene, sanitation, and regular deworming in preventing worm infestations. The ANMs, with their expertise, provided valuable insights into the transmission and prevention of these infections. Students were encouraged to adopt healthy practices, such as washing hands before meals and maintaining clean surroundings. The program not only addressed immediate health concerns but also instilled a sense of responsibility and awareness among the students regarding their personal and community health.

The success of the Deworming Day at GDC, Vedurukuppam, stands as a testament to the college's proactive approach towards student welfare. By fostering a collaborative spirit and leveraging community resources, the institution has taken a significant step in ensuring a healthier future for its students. 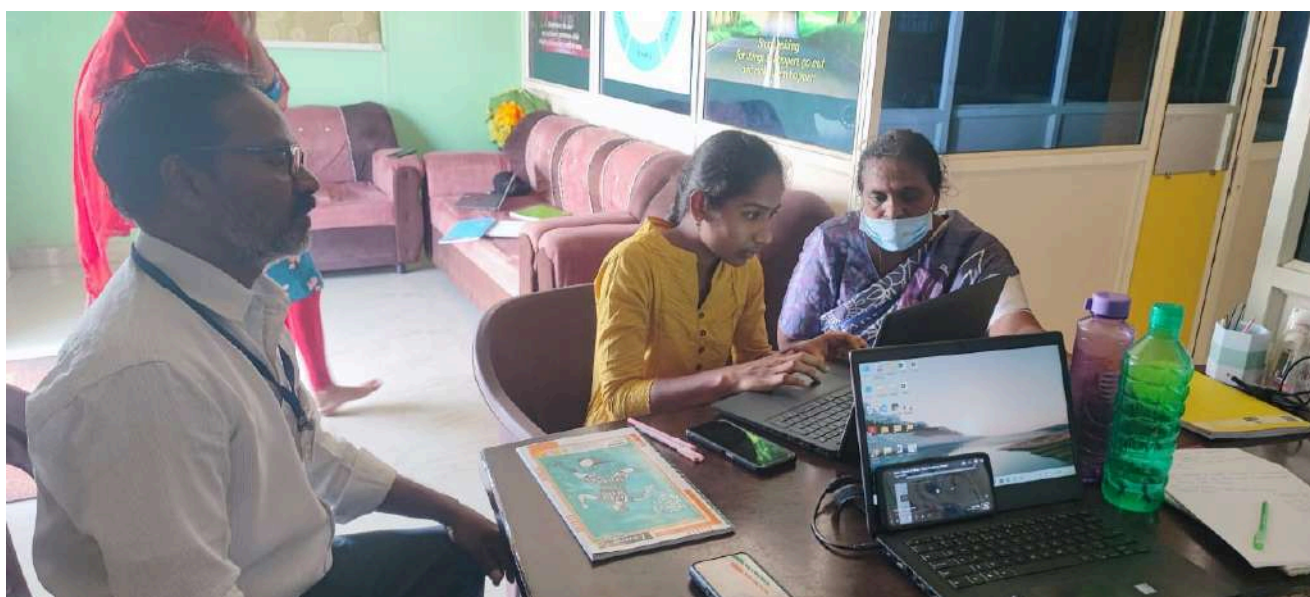
